### WLFS Online Safety

Online Safety is high on the Government agenda as it is an important part of safeguarding children. As part of our broad curriculum, we can teach and empower children to understand how to be safe and behave appropriately online. We recognise that school and parents /carers work in partnership to ensure children remember and apply what they have learnt to stay safe online. We also know that children increasingly use devices with internet access at home (phones, tablets, games consoles).

[Internetmatters.org](https://www.internetmatters.org) has published an extensive and informative guide to understanding online gaming and social media platforms.

**Fortnite** In the UK, the Video Standards council rate Fortnite as **PEGI 12** because it has frequent scenes of mild violence; it is not considered appropriate for first school aged children.

**Roblox.** Because the content on Roblox is user-generated, it doesn't fall under the same rigorous age ratings as content made by commercial companies. However, **PEGI** has altered their rating from PEGI 7 to Parental Guidance Recommended (PEGI !) because of the amount of user-generated content.

**Social Media:** The platforms below **require users to be 13+ as a minimum age.** Please follow the individual links for information on each one.

**YouTube.** To create a YouTube account you need to be 13+. However, you don't need an account to watch videos on the platform. Parents/carers have expressed concerns about the inappropriate content of some of the videos posted.
